Avanti Ltd. & Studebaker Drivers Club Picnic and Foundry Tour October 8, 2022

Come with us on October 8, 2022, to the joint meeting of Avanti Ltd. and Studebakers Drivers Club. We are touring up Highway 88 to Sutter Creek on Highway 49, just north of Jackson to see Knight Foundry.

What is Knight Foundry you ask? It is the last water-powered foundry and machine shop powered by water turbines and flat leather belts. It was established in 1873 and still functions today. Mr. Knight developed a water-powered turbine electric generator. (Like a Pelton Wheel, only different) Machines will be running, molten metal will be cast. See a 40-foot-long lathe. The Foundry is only open on the second Saturday of each month. The cost for the tour is \$15 each.




From I-80, take the Auburn Blvd Exit.
