The Aerospace Museum of California is an aviation museum located in North Highlands California on the grounds of the former McClellan Air Force Base. It features displays of authentic military and civilian aircraft as well as space vehicle replicas. It preserves the history and mission of this former



base as well as those of neighboring bases like Beale (active) and Mather (closed) Air Force Bases. McClellan Air Force Base closed in 2001 and became McClellan Business park. This display will be a blend automotive and aerospace history.

Prepping Your Car for Zone Meet Judging By: Jon Stalnaker/Editor

We are experimenting with a new method of recognizing special cars at our Zone Meet. We are not doing concours judging. We will be asking our volunteer judges to simply look over the field of cars and pick out their favorites in several categories. Mel France and I sat down and hammered out multiple categories that are flexible enough to be able to find first, second, and third winners in each category. We want to send participants home with all of the trophies and we plan to do just that.

We are asking the judges to select five cars for each category so that we will have extras to draw from should the same car be selected for multiple awards. Should that happen, Mel and I will give the highest award to that vehicle and move the other selections up in the other category. We do hope that it will be well received. Mel and I will be making the final decisions so what the judges turn in to us could be subject to change.

Since the judges will not be looking over your car with a fine tooth comb or looking for technical deficiencies, you can relax a bit and just enjoy yourselves. We are asking the judges to provide us with what they liked most about their selections and we will be sharing that during the award presentations. You need not be present when the judges come around but if you want to show off some cool features, feel free to share with the people carrying the clipboards.

Obviously, you want to clean your car and make sure that your interior is clear of clutter other than any display items you would like to share. The cleaner your car, the better it will look to the judge. Remember, this is NOT a concours judging and the decisions of the judges is totally up to what strikes their fancy.

We want you to have a good time and we wanted to take the stress out of having your hard work and passion looked over with a critical eye. Remember these awards are for our FAVORITE cars, not necessarily the Best cars.
